# **VEHICLE CATEGORY GUIDE**

The following is intended as a guide for vehicle categories. You may enter your vehicle in whichever category you feel is most suited, however you should be prepared to be judged on the appropriate criteria.

The Early Falcon Car Club of Victoria Inc. reserves the right to re-categorise vehicles, as advised by one of the judges, if a car is seen to be in the wrong category.

# **CATEGORY DEFINITIONS:**

**Standard:** Vehicles may be restored or partly restored. Accessories may be period, whether Ford original or aftermarket. Later accessories such as stereos, extractors, radial tyres etc. will be allowed, but the entry will lose points.

**Modified:** Any modification - mechanical, body or trim - will be classified as modified. This category will be split into two levels: 6 cylinder and V8.

# ONLY PRE-REGISTERS WILL BE JUDGED. All cars for judging need to be pre-registered by September 30.

# ROCKER COVER RACING RULES: There is no entry fee, as it's a fun event

# The Cars:

- No engines or propulsion, gravity only.
- No moving weights.
- No artificial weighting.
- Wheel can be attached to the car in any manner, but must not extend beyond the front of the valve cover.
- Nothing can extend beyond the front of the valve cover.
- Cars shall be based on an actual rocker cover from an automobile engine preferably Ford !.... Can be aluminium or steel .
- Cars must have four wheels, each no more than ten inches in diameter.
- Wheel must have a non-metallic surface contacting the track.

### The Races:

- Cars will be run in heats of two cars each.
- The cars are to be launched with their front wheels on the starting line. The first car to have its front wheels cross the finish line is the winner. If neither car makes it to the finish line, the car going the furthest in its lane wins.
- If the wheels a of a car should touch the lane markers or cross over the lane marker the car shall be disqualified. The competing car immediately becomes the winner.
- Winning cars will advance to the next round until all are eliminated except one car
- Judge's discussion is final

### The Prizes:

- Trophy for Rocker cover race champion, as determined by elimination heats.
- Best Rocker Cover Racer design.
